
PRINCE2™ 2009 Practitioner Exam Prep - 2 days

Program Overview

PRINCE2™ is a process-based approach for project management providing an easily tailored and scalable method for the management of all types of projects. PRINCE2™ is recognized as a world-class international product and is the de-facto standard method for project management in the UK and throughout the world. The PRINCE2™ method is in the public domain, offering non-proprietary, best practice guidance on project management. PRINCE2™ is a registered trademark of OGC.

The PRINCE2™ Practitioner Examination Preparation event provides an opportunity to apply and demonstrate learning of the PRINCE2 methodology to a real-life derived scenario. The successful completion of the Practitioner exams will give the delegate a recognized Practitioner qualification. This course lays a firm grounding for the delegate to apply the PRINCE2™ method to projects in the work place.

This course is designed for anyone who has already taken and passed the Foundation Exam. However the course is not suitable for anyone wishing to learn or substantially revise the PRINCE2 method. The expectation is that those attending will already have reached the standard of knowledge required, and have succeeded in passing the pre-requisite Foundation Examination.

Duration

The PRINCE2™ Practitioner Exam Preparation course is a two (2) day course that prepares participants for the certified PRINCE2™ Practitioner exam, which is an integral part of the course curriculum.

Delivery Method

Instructor-Led - The course comprises a mixture of input sessions, group exercises and examination based practical work. All delegates are encouraged to actively participate during the practical sessions to gain the full benefit during the training. During the course, delegates will undertake a number of mock examinations and gain feedback on the progress towards eventual success.

To prepare effectively for the PRINCE2™ Practitioner exam, delegates should be prepared to undertake revision and exam preparation work in the evening.

Target Audience

This course would benefit:

- Organizations or Individuals seeing the need for a controlled approach to managing projects
- Project Managers, General Managers, Team Managers and consultants needing a comprehensive understanding of all aspects of the project lifecycle along with the key management documents that should be created during each stage of your project

Prerequisites

For delegates to sit the Practitioners exam they MUST pass the Foundation exam. The Practitioner exam is the second of the two PRINCE2™ exams that candidates are required to pass to become a registered PRINCE2™ Practitioner.

Course Objectives

Following the completion of the course delegates will be able to:

- Show they understand the relationships between processes, themes, principles and PRINCE2 products and can apply this understanding to a given project scenario.
- Demonstrate that they understand the reasons behind the processes and themes of PRINCE2, and that they understand the principles underpinning these elements.
- Apply PRINCE2 to the running and managing of a project within an environment supporting PRINCE2
- Apply and tailor PRINCE2 to address the needs and problems of a specific project scenario and different project circumstances.
- State which management products are input to, or output from, the seven processes.
- State the main purpose, and key contents, of the major management products.
- State the relationships between processes, deliverables, roles and the management dimensions of a project.
- Pass the Practitioner exam
- Understand the level of responsibility, authority and accountability held by those involved in the project
- Articulate the steps needed to guide the project through controlled, well-managed and visible sets of activities to achieve the desired results.

Course Content

Certification - The purpose of the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam paper is to test a delegate's ability to apply the method. From September 2007 the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam changed from an open-ended essay style format to a multiple choice ("OTE" - Objective Testing Exam) format. The change from open-ended essay style format to multiple choice may seem to make the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam easier. However a broad knowledge is still required to pass this exam and initial feedback confirms that the exam is very much at the same level as the previous format.

The new PRINCE2 Practitioner exam format

- 9 questions, with a scenario background and appendices.
- Each of the 9 questions is worth 12 marks.
- An overall score of 59 out of 108 marks is required to pass. (55%)
- Two and a half hour duration.
- Open-book examination (only the PRINCE2 Manual is allowed)
